
THE FUTURE IS FLEXIBLE

Since our first survey in April of 2020, we've consistently heard that our employees want healthy, safe workspaces, wherever they're working. Here's what we heard most recently about the workplaces of the future:

86% said increasing cleaning/disinfecting was very important

86% expect the workplace to be disinfected regularly

72% said increasing the number of dividers and partitions was very important

86% want to know more about their company's cleaning process

87% want to limit the number of people in conference rooms

HEALTH AND SAFETY IS KEY

People want flexibility in where they work, but only if those spaces are clean and safe. The majority of people are still concerned about the pandemic and want to make sure that the space they're going back to is a healthy, safe space for them to work, whether that's their home, the office, a co-working space, or a hybrid model.
